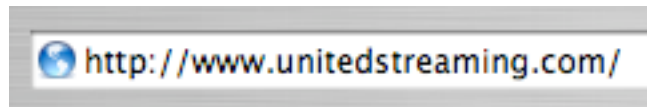


United Streaming—Videos

First we'll find a video and "stream" it.

1) Go to [Unitedstreaming.com](http://www.unitedstreaming.com)

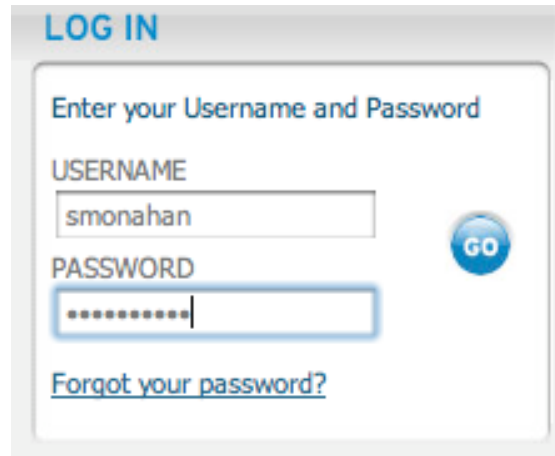


2) Log in.

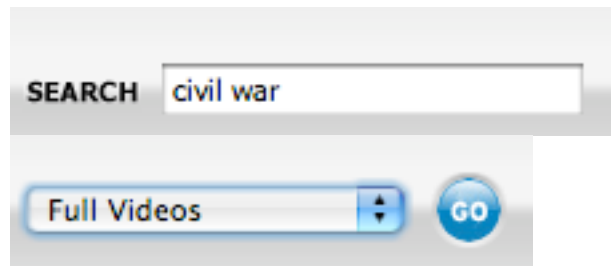
The generic (student) login for AISD is:

3) Search for a topic (by keyword) or for a specific video title. Choose Full Videos.



4) Click on the video title link. Note the grade levels and description.

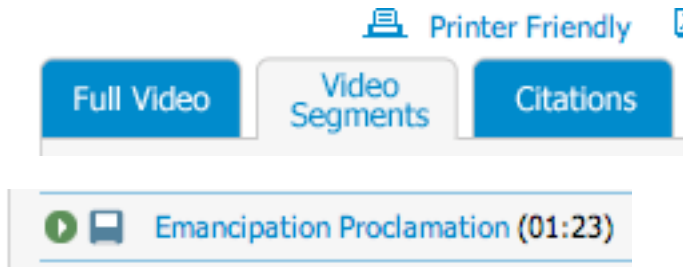
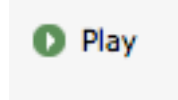


Media Player will already be loaded on Windows, and QuickTime on a Mac, although either is available for either platform by going to microsoft.com or apple.co

5) You can view a whole video or view segments. (Note the tabs) Click Play.



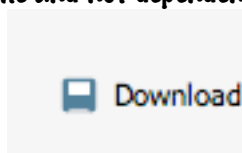
6) Viewing one segment can be very effective and focus on one aspect of a topic.



Now we'll learn to Download a Video or Video Segment

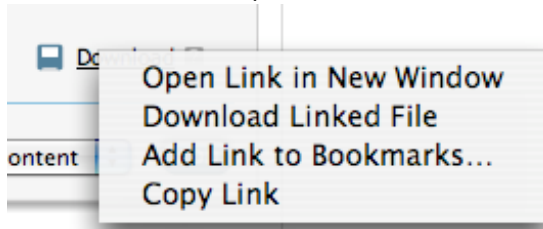
Download a Video (This saves the video on your Hard Drive to be used later. A downloaded video is available at any time and not dependent on an internet connection.)

- 1) Click the disk icon and movie will start to download onto your hard drive.

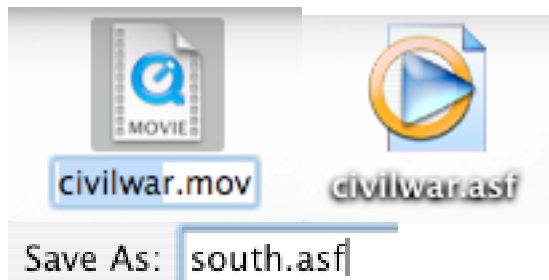


On a Mac, you may need to ctrl click on Download and choose Download Linked File.

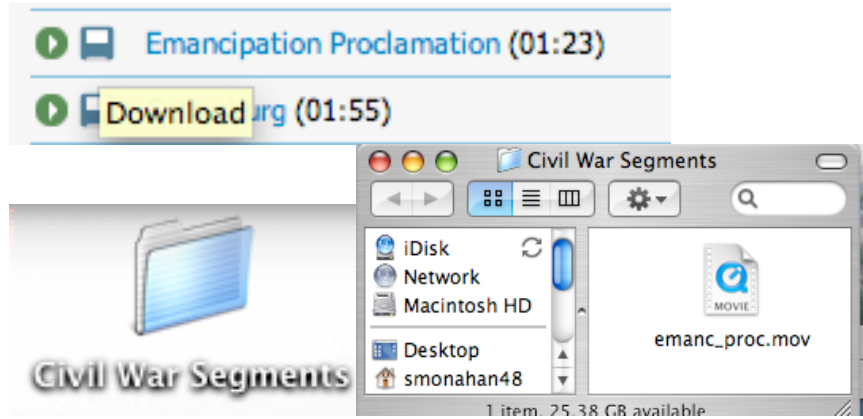
(Note: if your goal is to insert a video clip into PowerPoint, do QuickTime for Macs, and Media Player for Windows.)



2) The video will download to your desktop. You can rename the movie, but make sure to keep the .mov or .asf extension!



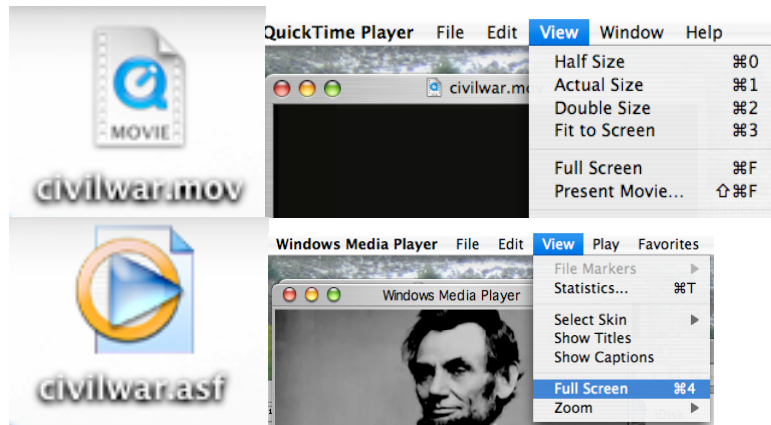
3) You can download video segments. You may want to make a folder before you do so to keep them organized.



4) To view the video, just double click it.

QuickTime: Click View and choose a size to view the video.

MediaPlayer: View and Full Screen.



Make use of the "power of pause". Use the movie controls to stop and start videos so the content can be discussed.
